



THE small PRINT IN DOOR GUARANTEES AND UL LABELS

Although you specify a guaranteed door, are you sure the door details in your drawings do not violate the guarantee? ALL guaranteed doors are based on the Standard Door Guarantee of National Woodwork Manufacturers' Association (NWMA).

If your drawings show cutouts for lights and/or louvers, any edge of which is nearer than 5" to any edge of the door
.....NO GUARANTEE

Less than 5"

If your drawings show cutouts for lights and/or louvers having less than 5" between adjacent cutouts for unit locks or other hardware cutouts NO GUARANTEE

If your drawings show cutout areas exceeding 40% of the area of the face of the doorNO GUARANTEE

If your drawings show cutouts exceeding one-half of the height of the door NO GUARANTEE

SUGGESTIONS:

- (1) Sketch in proposed hardware. It will be easy to detect oversized or misplaced cutouts.
- (2) Make lights narrower - if there's a question.
- (3) Place lights closer to the center of the door - if there's a question.

If your drawings show a metal vision panel and a fusible link louver in the same door NO UL LABEL. UL will allow only a metal vision panel or a fusible link louver, but not both.

If your drawings show pairs of wood fire doors without astragalsNO LABEL FROM UL.

If your specifications show any fusible link louver other than those approved by ULNO UL LABEL.

If your specifications show fusible link louvers to be job-site installed NO UL LABEL. (All louvers must be factory installed.)
